A coalition model, the Chinese American Coalition for Compassionate Care (CACCC) is the first coalition devoted to addressing end-of-life care concerns in the Chinese American community

Our Mission

- Encourage dialogue among Chinese Americans about end-of-life issues so that it is viewed as a natural part of life.
- Enhance advanced illness and end of life care by improving advance care planning and decision-making for Chinese Americans through community outreach education and volunteer, caregiver, and health professional training.
- Empower Chinese Americans by improving access to end-of-life resources: producing original Chinese language materials or translating existing materials into Chinese and providing referrals to appropriate agencies.
- Use a coalition model, where expertise and resources are shared, to ensure Chinese Americans receive exceptional end-of-life care and services that address physical, psychosocial, emotional and spiritual needs.

Our Vision

Build a community in which Chinese Americans are able to face the end of life with dignity and respect

Coalition Model

Award-winning, innovative leader in end-of-life education, CACCC consists of 250 global partners in US 67%, Canada 3%, Taiwan 10%, China 15%, Malaysia 3% and Hong Kong 2%.

Partners: Partner organizations include, but not limited to hospitals, hospices, palliative care collaboratives, nursing homes, senior centers, schools, funeral homes, community-based organizations, and churches.

Who We Serve

Provide global education and outreach to Chinese communities and the healthcare professionals who serve them through collaborations with partner organizations in the US, Canada, Taiwan, China, Malaysia, Hong Kong, and other countries.

Global Community Impact: From 2020-2025, CACCC held 1,277 hybrid programs and community events that reached 49,595 participants globally of which over 7,000 unique individuals participated, globally, in programs.

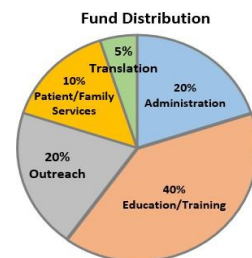
